#### **GO GUATEMALA**

We celebrate the life of Pastor Alex and his wife Evelyn with Go Guatemala. They've struggled to keep Go Guatemala open in the face of curfews & restrictions implemented for all educational institutions. They have found ways to make sure the children in their program continue receiving nutritional meals during the week as a non-profit organization and humanitarian aid. Also, Go Guatemala has kept their educational program, Big Brother, running so kids can continue having a safe place to spend time and use computers with access to printing materials and wifi.



On September 8, 2021, Mercedes Ruano, Pastor Alex's mother went to her eternal home with Jesus after being in the hospital for several weeks. Mercedes was one of the founders of Go Guatemala and helped cook for over 10 years. We honor her life as mother and tireless supporter of education and gang prevention in Zone 18 of Guatemala City. Her legacy will continue throughout the years.



# **NEEDS & PRAYER REQUESTS:**

**BIG BROTHER:** There is a need for Chrome books so children can attend classes and complete homework. Each of the three Big Brother locations is in need of 10 Chrome books for a total of 30. \$135.00 each for a total of \$4,030.00

**CHRISTMAS DINNER:** Go Guatemala will provide a Christmas event and dinner to 300 children. They are raising 50% of the cost for the meals within Guatemala. Help the children receive a Christmas dinner for only \$6 per child. Total needed: \$900.00.

#### LOVE & LAUGHTER DAY CARE CENTER

2021 was a very difficult year for their educational program. They were able to have children participate in their day care and education program in person and remotely. They only were closed 3 days the entire school year. Marlen and her staff were able to serve 24 children in this school year. We can appreciate the smiles on their faces at the graduation ceremony. What a blessing for each of the children to continue receiving the love and cave at Love & Laughter. This year they did receive their legal authorization from the Department of Education from the government in Guatemala to be open hybrid & virtual. Praise God!

### **NEEDS & PRAYER REQUESTS:**

**JORGE & MARLEN:** Prayers for them and the leaders of their ministry. The enemy is always trying to attack and destroy their lives. Pray for their relationship with God and each other as they serve together. Pray for their marriage to be stronger every day, for their two beautiful daughters, for their health, and their ministry.

**CHROME BOOKS:** Only 9 children have tablets to do their school work. They are in need of 15 additional Chrome books at \$135.00 each for a total of \$2,025.00.

**VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL:** Tesoros de Gracia Sakerti having their VBS in Dec. Prayers that they will be able to take the Word of God to children this year in three different locations. Two in Sakerti Zone 7, and one in Patzun – 50 miles away from Guatemala City in a rural area.







## TESOROS DE GRACIA CANALITOS



We celebrate the life of Pastor Erwin Luna, Shorty, his ministry, and each of the pastors that are leading at a Tesoros de Gracia church. It was a blessing that all of the six churches were able to remain open during the pandemic; some are having their services outside so people can continue to hear the Word of God. We continue to pray for safety for the churches as they are all located in red areas of Guatemala City where violence continues to take the lives of many young people.

**SANTA FAZ - ZONE 6:** Pastor Shorty is the lead pastor of this church and he has seen many people come together to worship the Lord. People are hungry of the Word of God.

**SAKERTI** - **ZONE 7:** Pastor Jorge Sipaque has continued work in the community where he Is from. He and his church have cleaned parks in the community allowing children a safe and clean place too play. Sharing the Word of God through games, sports, activities, and parties has led to many children and their families coming to know Jesus.

**CANALITOS** - **ZONE 24:** Despite the harm local gangs attempted to cause Pastor Abigail Rodriguez and his family this year, they continued to preach God's word and create change in their community. They were able to open a public water faucet as there is no running water in there. God is good!

**LOURDES 1 - ZONE 5:** Pastor Abi also works on this side of La Limonada. This church has had some dark times due to the violence of gangs. Despite this, they have been able to continue having their doors open to people who want to find rest in Jesus.

**LOURDES 2 LA LIMONADA** - **ZONE 5:** Pastor Marco Tulio Lopez, at 66 years old, is the oldest pastor at Tesoros de Gracia Canalitos. But you would never know, his spirit continues to be strong and he continues to reach out to his community by serving the children and their families every week.

**LA ALAMEDA- ZONE 18:** Pastor Rafa – Rafael Valiente celebrated their first anniversary this year. The Alameda church is the most recent church plant of Tesoros de Gracia; they started with 30 families and today have over 40 families coming to church several days a week. Their feeding program has been able to serve over 70 children and their community has been learning how to give. This recent anniversary celebration was paid for 100% by people from Zone 18. What a blessing!
